Your group can expect to meet a selection of HVZ's ambassador animals, like invertebrates, small reptiles, small mammals, or birds. Programs include age-appropriate thematic content based on Next Generation Science Standards and best practices in empathybased interpretation.

#### CRITTER CONNECTIONS

Groups visiting the zoo can schedule 30-minute, onsite programs on weekdays and as availability allows. Programs can accommodate up to 50 participants in the zoo's indoor classroom, or up to 100 participants in the zoo's outdoor Education Pavilion.

Pricing for Critter Connections starts at \$50 per program.

#### ZOO TO YOU

Bring zoo animals to your group with our education outreach programs! HVZ educators travel to public locations within Dane County on weekdays and as availability allows. This option is great for community centers, nursing homes, and school visits.

Pricing for Zoo to You programs starts at \$150 per program.

#### VIRTUAL CRITTER CONNECTIONS

Visit the zoo virtually and meet some of our amazing ambassador animals from the comfort of your classroom. Virtual Critter Connections are 30-minute programs and are a great addition to camp and class curriculum.

Pricing for virtual programs is \$30. To make this program as accessible as possible, we offer a pay what you can model.

#### Senses and Defenses - Ages Pre K-Adult


It's a big world out there for an animal, learn all about how animals protect themselves and sense the world around them through their amazing adaptations.
